Council Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, November 8, 2023 (6:00 pm)

UNAPPROVED

Devotions: Bryan

Moderator John Butterbrodt called the meeting to order at 6:00. Members present: Bea, Bryan, Dennis, John, Karen, Peggy M, Sharon A, Sharon O, Spencer & Sue. John talked about the Zoom session with Emily Meyer that will take place at 6:30 (see 7A).

- **1. Review, Modify, and Approve the Agenda:** Add 7B—Reimagination Grant from MN Conference; 7C—Workman's Comp; 7D—MN Employment Laws; 8—LAHBN requesting for 3 events. Approve as modified: Spencer/Bea/U.
- 2. Review, Modify and Approve Minutes of October 11, 2023: Approve: Sharon A/Bea/U.
- 3. Committee Reports
 - **A. Christian Education:** Sharon A shared Peggy K's emailed report. Committee will meet Tuesday. Circle of Stones is doing a book study and Sunday school materials are on hand when needed.
 - **B.** Worship, Sanctuary, and Membership: Christmas Eve service will be regular Sunday time and Cynthia will play the piano for it. Karen will preach Nov 12, Nov 26, Dec 17 & 31. Decorating for Christmas will be done after church on Nov 26, followed by a potluck.
 - C. Building and Maintenance: Dennis contacted Rob Bremer about the roof and he put flashing up to direct water to the gutter. There is heat tape up there and Dennis will check to see if it's working. He has been catching rodents. Sharon O noted that MBSG got a \$200 donation to use for the wall repairs or other outside maintenance. Snow blowing: the north entrance will need to be kept clear for activities held in the basement. Bea will call Soderstrom to see if he can do it. John will let Stan know about this.
 Zoom session with Emily Meyer (see 7A).
 - **D. Stewardship:** November is Food Shelf and December will be the Christmas Fund. The committee will meet with Sharon O and Konnie to prepare the 2024 Budget Proposal. The discussion of the budget is scheduled for Dec 3rd.
 - **E. Memorials and Bequests:** Year-to-date remainder is \$4,704.35. School defibrillator information did not come in time for the meeting, so will be allocated later.
 - F. Pastor Parish Committee: Not met.
 - G. Wider Church Happenings: None

- 4. **Financial Report:** Sharon O got a solicitation from another insurance company. Bank balance for October 31st is \$19,074.69.
- 5. Pastor's Report: None
- 6. Old Business
 - A. Display Case for Bible: Bryan has measured the items to into the case and described what he plans to build.
 - B. Church Secretary: Peggy K sent a message that Lisa Putz will be applying for the position.
 - C. Handrails to Access Altar Area: Railings will be installed by Thanksgiving.
 - D. West Side Retaining Wall: Nothing new
 - **E.** Welcome ceremony for Cynthia Huse: Karen has come up with the Liturgy. It can be done Dec 3 or 10 as Cynthia will be here those dates. John will check on which works best.

F. Ongoing Pulpit Supply:

Cynthia Huse will serve communion Sundays with flexibility to reschedule it as needed. Karen Schmidt-Dill will lead worship two Sundays a month.

Lay readers will fill in on remaining Sundays as needed. Nov 19 needs to be filled yet.

The possibility of getting a Seminary student to come out to preach. John is hopeful that the Emily Meyer connection could help.

The MN Conference sent John information of two possible options: 1) A comprehensive survey whose results would suggest directions we could go. 2) The Innovation Culture Index, which costs \$100. This was created in conjunction with United Seminary and finds the capacity of a church to go in a new direction and finds the will of its membership. John got the information on these options and sent it to the Council members.

7. New Business:

- A. Zoom meeting with Emily Meyer (United Seminary): (6:30 PM)
 - •Emily will provide an overview of the Innovation Culture Index (ICI).
 - •John will bring his computer for the meeting. One computer is all we need.

The Innovation Culture Index (ICI, cost \$100) is 40 questions online. A paper copy can be used and data entered by a trusted leader (Karen volunteered to do this). It measures congregational vitality and resilience, the ability to navigate change. Emily went over the 9 areas covered in the survey, which will be adapted to our congregation. When completed, there will be personal scores in addition to a community score. The process was reviewed—we need as large a group as possible and a broad range of people to answer it. Emily would come out and go over the results with the Council and other designated members. There would also be a debrief session with 5-10 congregational leaders to discuss what was learned and what our next steps might be. We would also have the option of participating in a n 18-month Transformational Lab (cost about \$4000, but MN Conference offsets some and a small amount available from Innovation Lab). This would be done with a team of 5-7 members in monthly meetings and the leader meets with Emily an extra time each month. There would be projects for the Team to complete between meetings.

Motion to participate in ICI: Sue/Spencer/U. John will let Emily know.

The Transformational Lab will be discussed with the congregation at the Annual Meeting in January.

- **B. Reimagination Grant:** Up to \$2000 available from MN Conference to make changes. We can apply for this after we get the results of the ICI.
- **C. Workman's Comp:** Sharon O noted that the bill arrived. After the audit (about Dec 6) the amount will be adjusted.
- D. MN Employment Laws: Sharon O ordered a copy of the 2024 version—it will arrive after Jan 1st.
- **8. Church Use Requests:** (Perhaps incomplete.)
 - Take Note is rehearsing here Tuesday evenings.
 - •Living at Home Block Nursing: Living Well with Chronic Conditions: Tuesday and Thursdays, November 7-November 28, 1:00-3:00.

LAHBN requests: 1) Tuesdays Nov 14, 11:30-1:00, for Grief Group. This will continue as a monthly session with dates set for the following months at each meeting. 2) Wednesdays Nov 15, 22, 29, Dec 6, 13, 20, 27 and Jan 3, 10:30-12:00, for Healing Connections Aftercare. 3) Tuesday Dec 5, 2:00-3:30 for Volunteer Christmas Tea.
